

LSA 2026 Higher Education Scholarship

Monetary amount: \$500

There has been money allotted from our Midway USA Foundation Endowment Grant for scholarships for youth in 12th grade that are graduating from high school and have been accepted for continuing education in a higher institute of learning such as:

1. Four Year College
2. Two Year College
3. Trade School
4. Prep School

This will be a one-time monetary award to be used for direct educational expenses, including tuition, books, or school equipment, such as a personal computer.

The applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. Must have been a member (individual or family) of LSA for at least two years and must be a current active member (participant).
2. Must have been a participant in a youth program at LSA, including one of the organized youth teams (Buckshots, High Caliber, Air2Spare, archery, or youth hunts). The athlete must have participated in one of these programs for at least one season. Preference will be given to youth that are active members.
3. Will submit at least a one-page essay of what being a member of the LSA youth programs has meant to her/him/them, and include ideas, events, or people that have influenced them during their membership here.

Submissions must include the athlete's name, mailing address, program(s) they participated in, current member activities, and the higher education institute that they have been accepted to. If acceptance is pending, please note that in the application letter.

All applications will be reviewed by the Youth Programs Committee, and a recommendation will be made to the Board of Directors for granting the scholarship. Applications are due by midnight on Saturday, May 16th, 2026, to be awarded at the Membership Meeting on Wednesday, June 3rd, 2026, at 7pm in the Main Clubhouse.
